Overview

Generator in tandem with the MMF are looking for three music managers at the tipping point of their careers. Experienced in music management, and the wider music industry, you should be 'on top of' the ever changing landscape that current managers now operate in. The programme will last approximately 6 months & you will receive training from MMF, mentoring from a project lead, attendance of national events and be expected to help develop a new level 3 qualification in music management

Responsibilities include:

- Attending mentorship sessions to receive 2 hours of direct 1:1 support per week and a 4-hour monthly planning session. You will also be expected to travel nationally for MMF sessions and other associated training and conferences
- Working with aspiring professionals to support their journey into management
- Supporting on workshops for larger groups of managers at an early stage in their career
- Alongside the project lead, develop and deliver modules for a new level 3 in music management, signed off by MMF and successfully accredited with our partners
- Complete all training as directed by the project lead and MMF

A successful candidate will have:

- Experience and passion for working in the music sector
- A proven track record in music management, artist management, publishing, etc
- A passion for the North East music scene
- A demonstrable network to assist professionals
- An understanding of level 3 requirements

Contract value:

- You will be paid up to £3,000 for all MMF and development time at a rate of £15 p/h.
- Total expected hours are projected to be 276 across the 6-month period with circa 200 of those being development hours.
